2016	The First Tee of Fort Worth begins programming at Squaw Creek with 300 participants.
	The U.S. Census Bureau reports that 25% of Parker County residents are under 18.
2017	Participation at the Squaw Creek location grows to over 1,000 participants per week.
	Ben Hogan Foundation Board of Directors approves new Ben Hogan Learning Center at Squaw Creek.
2018	Programming at the Squaw Creek location is at capacity. Capital Campaign launches.
	A North Central Texas Council of Governments report predicts the 2030 population of Parker County to be over 328,000 individuals, up from 129.411 in 2017.

Developing techniques for managing thoughts and emotions, using good judgment, staying calm under pressure and building confidence.


### **Goal-Setting**
