Spectator Rules and Match Information PGA Jr. League Ages 6-13 Rivers Edge Par 3 Course

Format - This league we play a scramble format. All players hit a shot from their tee box, once all players have hit, then the players decide what is the best ball to choose. All other balls are picked up and everyone plays again from the selected spot until a ball is holed.

Matches - All teams are paired to have a match against the team in front of them or behind them. Each 2 holes played is worth a point for their team each week. Scorecards are reviewed between the 2 teams at the end of each match to see how their team did that match.

Check-in - Please check-in with the First Tee PGA Coaches at the table with the PGA Jr. League logo on it. This check-in will be located in the bottom parking lot of the Rockwood golf course near the pavilion area towards the driving range. There will be a big PGA Jr. League flag as well to look for.

Team Gear - If you signed up for PGA Jr. League prior to March 1 your team gear has arrived and will be distributed at the pavilion area. Players will know what shirt (blue or orange) to wear by the highlighted color of their team on the tee times pairing sheet. All other gear will be ordered once everyone has completed registration and will be distributed once it arrives.

Practice - There will be range balls on the driving range for players to hit prior to their tee times. We usually also will have a coach at the range to be helpful to any participant that could use a swing tip before the round.

When to arrive - Please arrive in time to be checked-in at least 10 minutes before your tee time. Do not let the app fool you, the time displayed is for the very first tee time. Please make sure to check the tee time sheet sent out and posted on the website each week.

Parent expectations - This is a beginner fun league. Root for all kids playing in the group. Help where needed for safety. Carry a bag for your kid if they need assistance but try to have them start carrying and being responsible for their clubs as it is healthy to carry or push them around the course while they play. Players should be encouraged to work together and pick the best shot. Parents should not pick the best shot for the group.

Cart rental - There is no carts to be rented for use of spectating on the Rivers Edge course. Everyone will need to walk that wants to watch.

Length of match - Usually everyone is done playing within 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours from the start of their tee time.
